Summary

- The Board reviewed work being undertaken across various areas of AITSL and identified areas for further engagement and reach.
- The participation rate in the teacher survey for the Australian Teacher Workforce Data (ATWD) initiative was discussed and the Board noted that the current response rate provides a very robust sample nationally, but any increase allows reporting for smaller groups or geographical areas without raising privacy concerns. The Board appreciated the need for support from systems and sectors to promote participation to see the benefits of greater response rates.
- The Board had a robust discussion about AITSL's strategic risk environment and the key risks for Management to monitor and mitigate in 2023.
- The Board undertook a workshop to develop ideas for a long-term strategy to esteem the profession.
- The Board noted an update on the Professional Standards for Middle Leaders and requested AITSL provide them with regular updates on the project.
