

AITSL Board Meeting Report: 28 August 2015

Strategic and Future Directions in Teaching and School Leadership

The Board continued its discussion from the previous meeting on the strategic and future directions for AITSL's work in teaching and school leadership, including a focus on approaches and strategies that will have the greatest impact in improving teaching and school leadership.

Initial Teacher Education

The Board received an update on progress in implementing the Government's response to the Teacher Education Ministerial Advisory Group (TEMAG). The Board reviewed and approved AITSL's submissions to the Education Council seeking endorsement of the Selection Guidelines and the timing of transition to the strengthened accreditation approach.

Early Career Teachers

The Board was provided with an update of AITSL's work in developing the Australian Beginning Teachers Guidelines. The advancement of these guidelines is in response to the TEMAG Report which recommends that AITSL develop a nationally consistent approach to the induction of new teachers.

Highly Accomplished and Lead Teacher Network

The Board were given an update on AITSL's work in establishing a Highly Accomplished and Lead Teacher Network. This network will allow AITSL to collaborate with and seek expert practitioner input from teachers that are recognised as leaders in their field.

AITSL 2014-2015 Annual Report

The Board discussed and approved the AITSL 2014-2015 Annual Report. It is anticipated that the Annual Report will be available on the AITSL website in October.
