

HIGHLY ACCOMPLISHED AND LEAD TEACHER NETWORK ACTIONS 2016–17

In March 2016, over 120 nationally certified teachers gathered in Adelaide for the inaugural Highly Accomplished and Lead Teacher (HALT) Summit. This action plan brings together the ideas that emerged from the Summit which were then prioritised and further refined by the HALT Steering Group at a meeting in early June 2016.

This plan has been developed to share the priority Network actions in 2016-17 with members and outline how they might get involved or contribute to helping build the success of the Network.
