



# HAILEYBURY

Derek Scott is the CEO | Principal of Haileybury and the Chair of the Australian Curriculum, Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA).

Haileybury has four campuses in Melbourne with 4800 students and operates Haileybury Rendall School in Darwin with 850 students including 90 indigenous boarders from remote communities. Haileybury also has programs delivering Australian education in ten cities in China, Vietnam, the Philippines and Timor-Leste. Haileybury is launching Haileybury Pangea in 2023, a virtual campus of Haileybury.

Derek has been the Chair of ACARA since November 2021. He was one of a panel of four who conducted the Quality Initial Teacher Education Review for the Federal Government in 2021. Derek is on the Federal Government's International Education Council, the Victorian Government's International Education Expert Advisory Group and is the Chair of the Associated Public Schools of Victoria.

He is an expert in school improvement and opening new schools and campuses having opened Haileybury City, Haileybury Tianjin, Haileybury Rendall School and Haileybury Pangea during his time as CEO | Principal. Prior to joining the teaching profession, he had a career as a journalist.

He was awarded the Australian Principal of the Year at the 2019 Australian Education Awards.
