

What is a wireless FM system?

A wireless FM system helps individuals better understand speech by cutting out distracting background noise. It works in conjunction with hearing aids (or with a headset) to deliver the sounds directly to an individual's ears.

FM systems and children

One of the most common uses of FM systems is by children with a hearing loss in the classroom or classroom settings. This is because children who wear hearing aids often have difficulty understanding a teacher's words over long distances and when there is a lot of background noise.

When noise levels increase, children with hearing loss or attention issues often struggle to differentiate important speech sounds—such as their teacher's voice—from the surrounding noise.
