Facts about Queensland

- Queensland is the second largest state in Australia
 with the third largest population and covers
 1,723,030 square kilometres. It's characterised by
 a diverse landscape that includes tropical islands,
 sandy beaches, flat river plains, elevated terrain, dry
 deserts, and densely populated urban areas.
- As of December 2023, Queensland has over 5.5 million residents with a majority living outside of the capital city area of Greater Brisbane.
- Queensland is renowned for its world-famous Great Barrier Reef, the ancient Daintree Rainforest, the stunning beaches of the Whitsunday Islands, and the culturally rich Tjapukai Aboriginal Cultural Park.
- The education sector in Queensland includes a total of 1,797 schools as of 2023, comprising a mix of Government (69.6%), Catholic (17.4%), and Independent (13.0%) institutions.


