### **Facts about Tasmania**

- Tasmania is the smallest state in Australia and covers an area of 68,401 square kilometres. It's landscape includes the mountainous terrain of the Central Highlands, the temperate rainforests of the Tarkine, and the stunning coastline of the South Arm Peninsula.
- As of December 2023, Tasmania is home to over 574,000 residents with a majority living outside of the capital city area of Greater Hobart.
- Tasmania is renowned for its natural attractions including the world-famous Freycinet National Park, Cradle Mountain-Lake St Clair National Park, Port Arthur Historic Site, and Bruny Island, which offer remarkable vistas, unique flora and fauna, and insights into Tasmania's past.
- The education sector in Tasmania includes a total of 261 schools as of 2023, comprising a mix of Government (72.4%), Catholic (14.6%), and Independent (13.0%) institutions.
