Facts about Victoria

- Victoria, the smallest mainland state in Australia spans an area of 227,444 square kilometres that includes a range of climates and geographical features from temperate coastal and central regions to the Victorian Alps in the northeast and the semiarid northwest.
- As of December 2023, Victoria is home to over 6.9 million residents with the majority living within the capital city area of Greater Melbourne.
- Victoria is renowned for its natural and cultural attractions, including the iconic Twelve Apostles on the Great Ocean Road, the Yarra Valley, the Melbourne Museum, and the Werribee Open Range Zoo.
- The education sector in Victoria has a total of 2,283 schools as of 2023, comprising a mix of Government (68.3%), Catholic (21.9%), and Independent (9.8%) institutions.
