

Tips

- Engage in professional conversations with your mentee on the resources they have read.
- Support your mentee further by directing them to other related professional readings or resources.

Simulate scenarios & complete quizzes

Complete scenarios and quizzes on topics ranging from lesson planning to workplace behaviour.

Tips

- Explore a scenario with your mentee and discuss their response, or invite them to observe you in action, in a similar scenario.
- Encourage your mentee to complete a quiz and discuss it with you.

- Encourage your mentee to download the calendar together with you.
- Use the prompts to structure your mentoring or initiate regular checkins and reflections.

- Advise your mentee on the importance of regular wellbeing check-ins, and guide them tto reflect on their wellbeing levels.
- Discuss strategies with your mentee to better manage their wellbeing.
