Note how the teacher has dated the actions and added questions to prompt further thinking.

<p>Step 4: Assess your performance Determine how much progress you've made. If you have met your goal, are you ready for a new one?</p>	<p>Progress: Student survey indicates inclusive culture has improved in class Learning activities are inconsistently hitting the mark, some students still acting bored</p> <p>Next steps: Focus on one subject to apply inclusive academic approach</p> <p>Change goal to: Within the next terms, I will focus on making maths more inclusive but also through differentiated challenging classroom activities</p> <p>Ask Ms Patel about her Maths practice? Maybe observe a Maths lesson in her class?</p>
